



Veteran Concerns

The VA announced on January 13, 2017 that 8 diseases are granted presumptive status for service connection disability for Veterans and Reservists who served at Camp Lejeune for at least 30 days (cumulative) between August 1, 1953 and December 31, 1987.

The eight diseases are: adult leukemia, aplastic anemia and other myelodysplastic syndromes, bladder cancer, kidney cancer, liver cancer, multiple myeloma, non-Hodgkin's lymphoma and Parkinson's disease.
